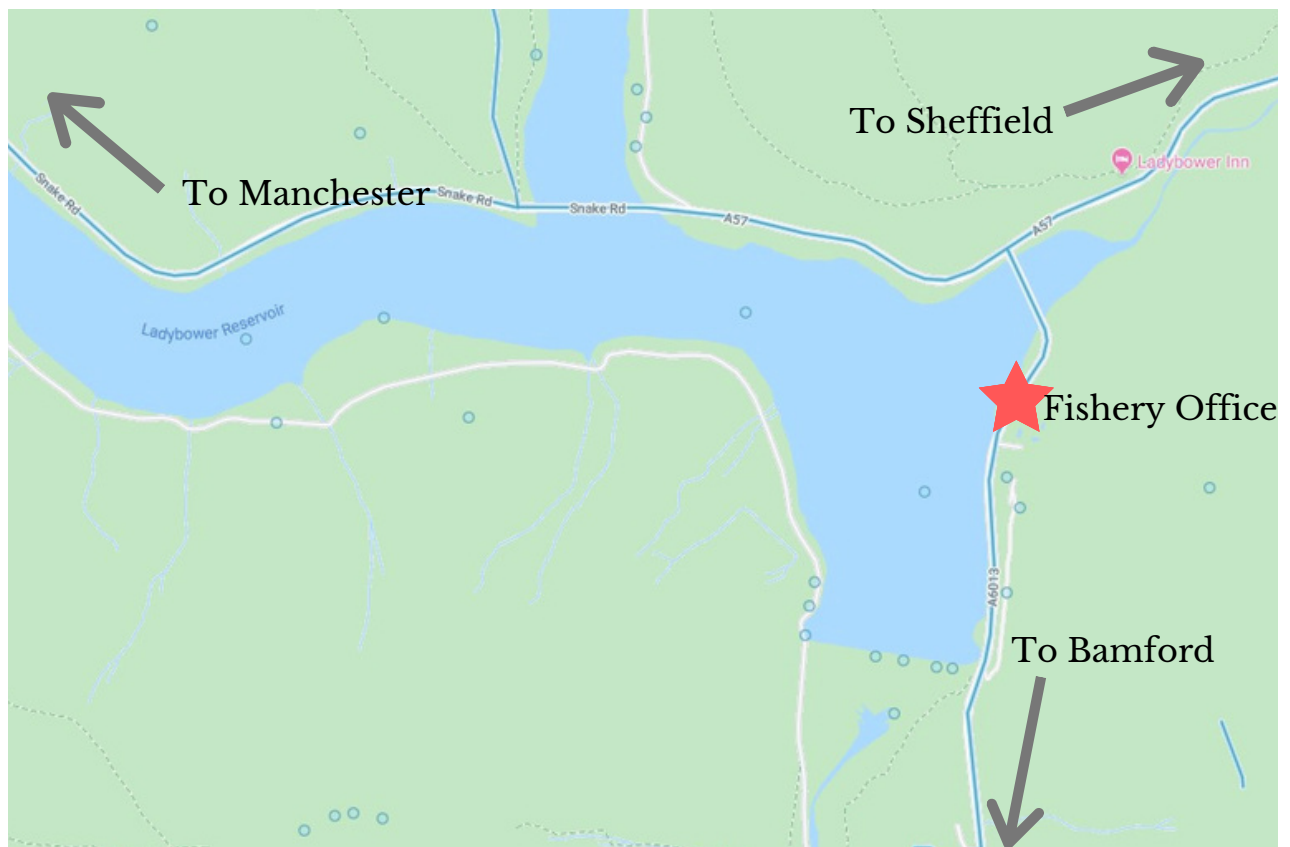

Packed lunch & snacks if required
Water / Soft drink / Hot Drink if required
Layers of clothing such as t-shirts, fleeces
Waterproofs (Top and trousers if possible)
Sunglasses / Glasses *
Peaked cap or hat *
Any medicines, inhalers, Insect Repellent etc.
Your EA Rod Licence (See below)
