A tailored approach

Tuition is tailored to each individual's experience; we are used to catering for a wide range of levels from complete novices to experienced anglers within the same group. CHECKLIST

What you should bring on the day

- » Sunglasses / glasses
- » Peaked cap or hat
- » Any medicines, inhalers etc

TUITION COSTS & LICENCING

Dotting the i's & crossing the t's

COSTS:

The cost of your day will depend on many factors such as the fishing venue, the size of your group & the type of catering that you require. After discussing your requirements we will send a fully itemised quotation for your event.

ROD LICENCES:

In the UK it is illegal to fish without a valid *Environment Agency* rod licence. If your participants are trying fishing for the first time then they will be covered by the instructor's rod licence by filling out a simple form on the day of tuition.

If your participants have fished before they will need to have a valid rod licence. We will arrange all the required rod licences on your behalf before your event.
